


Category I: Prohibited Practices on Permanent Basis

- Youth marketing
- Operating or directly funding youth education
- Depiction of persons under 35
- Use of cartoon imagery
- Selling flavors not approved by the FDA
- Comparing nicotine amounts/ nicotine content
- Outdoor advertising near schools/billboards
- Paid social media influencers
- Direct to consumer ads


Category II: Prohibited Practices for next six years

- Product placement at adult-only facilities
- Sale of brand-name merchandise
- Access to websites without age verification
- Paid sponsorships at adult-only facilities
- Advertising for audience 85% adult-aged
- Public transportation advertising
- Social media advertising
- Samples
- Product displays in stores, online sales

Non-Monetary Provisions

- Refrain from marketing directly or indirectly to youth
- Limit number of retail and online purchases per individual
- Retail compliance checks
- Treat synthetic nicotine as nicotine
- No samples
- Product placement prohibited in virtual reality systems
- Submit documents into depository



STATE AG SETTLEMENTS THE 7-MULTISTATE SETTLEMENTS- APRIL 2023

The Document Depository Provisions

- Similar to the depository est. from NC settlement
- Make publicly available evidence produced in litigation
- Exceptions (privileged communications; trade secrets; etc.)
- Settling states may object to withheld documents
- Must be accessible and free to the public in perpetuity



Juul said in its press release announcing the settlement with the State of Minnesota on April 17, 2023.



THE SOLVENCY QUESTION *WHAT HAPPENS IF JUUL GOES BANKRUPT?*

- Chapter 11 is a form of bankruptcy that involves the reorganization of a debtor business's affairs, debts, and assets.
- Chapter 11 allows a company to stay in business while its debt obligations are restructured.
- Any reorganization plan must be in the best interest of the creditors and approved by the bankruptcy court.
- Debts can and often are renegotiated (can include liquidation of assets to pay creditors).





THE SOLVENCY QUESTION *WHAT HAPPENS IF JUUL GOES BANKRUPT?*

- The 33-multistate settlements contain an Affirmation of Agreement in Bankruptcy.
- The 7-multistate settlements allow for judgment on liability on damages OR immediate collection efforts by the AGs.
- MDL settlements: unclear if reaffirmation or other agreements made.
- Any payouts will be subject to Bankruptcy Court approval and lifting of the automatic stay regardless of settlement provisions.
